I'm Javier Eduardo Lozano Peña. I'm a 9th grade FESA student. I was selected as the Student of the Month because my perseverance and effort in class and my commitment to sport. I have an average of 9 (equivalent to a GPA of 3.6) even when I had hard baseball trainings: the sport I love.

My father Carlos is a teacher and my mother Milagro de Jesus is a restless fighter to keep our home together. I was born in San Salvador in April 24, 1993.

In 2001, the Foundation Educating a Salvadorian (FESA) open its doors because my performance in baseball. I am pitcher and I considered FESA's option because you can become more productive and successful in sports when you are a professional and do what you love: play the game.

I remember when I was 10 years old I set a goal for myself: I want to play in the Major League Baseball [MLB]. My first trip was to Guatemala. Then I traveled to Honduras, Nicaragua and Panama for the William Sport Tournament.

Friends and neighbors ask me why I am in FESA. I respond that FESA is an organization which is opening a successful window to this sport [baseball] with top competitions in El Salvador. I say to them that FESA empowers athletes' creativity, intelligence and that fighting spirit for winning. Without FESA, my sport would not have Salvadorian representatives in minor leagues of MLB and as I said before, my dream is to put on the world's eyes, a *FESA Salvadorian*.

What is FESA doing for me?

I received a full scholarship to study and professionally train baseball with real trainers; FESA is giving the opportunity to get known in other countries participating in regional and national tournaments. I have grown stronger mindset that allows me to train 3 to 4 hours per day and still being a top student dedicating 5 - 6 hours in the afternoon to my school tasks. At the same time, FESA is helping me to grow internally my love for God and values. I have more discipline, I respect others, I love my family and I value my country more every day. I go to church every Sunday and I help my siblings in Christ
